Sub: Annual Plan 2018-19-Scheme on 'Modernization of Departmental Laboratories' - Strengthening of Central Soil and Plant Health Centre, District Soil Testing Laboratories, Mobile Soil Testing Laboratories- modifications in working instructions-issued

Working instructions of the component 'Strengthening of Central Soil and Plant Health Centre, District Soil Testing Laboratories, Mobile Soil Testing Laboratories' under Scheme on 'Modernization of Departmental Laboratories' was issued as per the reference 1st cited, wherein an amount of Rs. 125 lakh was allotted to the Chief Soil Chemist for implementation of the scheme. The Chief Soil Chemist was also directed to allot funds to Assistant Soil Chemists of 14 District Soil Testing Laboratories and nine Mobile Soil Testing Laboratories for the repair and AMC of equipments, purchase of glassware, postage stamps, hiring of vehicle, POL, infrastructure development including refilling of gas cylinders, repair and maintenance of computers, need based purchases, etc., based on their requirement.

As per reference 2nd cited, it was informed that the Principal Agricultural Officers are not monitoring the captioned scheme and entering data in PLANSPACE for which funds are directly given to the Assistant Soil Chemists through the Chief Soil Chemist, even though they are under the direct control of the Principal Agricultural Officers. Consequent to non updation of data in PLANSPACE, discrepancies are noticed between treasury figures and departmental figures, which cannot be accepted. Hence, it was directed to assign the target of component/ schemes for which funds are directly given to the Assistant Soil Chemists through the Chief Soil Chemist to the concerned Principal Agricultural Officers, so that they can enter the data in PLANSPACE.

As per reference 3rd cited, the Chief Soil Chemist has furnished the details of funds allotted to the Assistant Soil Chemists of 14 District Soil Testing Laboratories and nine Mobile Soil Testing Laboratories under the captioned scheme, which is as follows:
