ORDER

In the Budget 2018-19 an amount of Rs. 2833.00 lakhs has been provided under the Head of Account 2401-00-800-28(P) for the scheme 'Soil and Root Health Management & Productivity Improvement'. Under the scheme there are 2 continuing components implemented through Vegetable & Fruit Promotion Council Keralam as follows:

2. The Director of Agriculture Development and Farmers' Welfare Department as per his letter read above has submitted a project proposal for the first component titled 'Soil test based nutrient application in vegetable and banana in Thiruvananthapuram, Pathanamthitta and Ernakulam' for an amount of Rs.52.00 lakh and a project proposal for the second component titled 'Soil testing labs through VFPCK' for an amount of Rs.25.00 lakh and has requested to accord Administrative Sanction. The abstract of the particulars of the proposals is as follows:

I) Soil test based nutrient application in vegetable and banana in Thiruvananthapuram, Pathanamthitta and Ernakulam.

- 3) The Working Group meeting held on 26.04.2018 and 08.05.2018 considered the above proposals and approved the same subject to the condition that the amount Rs. 25 lakh kept for the component "soil testing labs " will be given this year only for meeting running expenditure and such assistance will not be given in future and VFPCK itself should raise the fund for meeting these expenditure from their revenue in future.
- 4) Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to accord Administrative Sanction for the implementation of the project proposals 'Soil test based nutrient application in vegetable and banana in Thiruvananthapuram, Pathanamthitta and Ernakulam' for an amount of Rs.52.00 lakhs and 'Soil testing labs through VFPCK' for an amount of Rs.25.00 lakhs ie., at a total cost of Rs.77 lakh (Rupees Seventy Seven lakhs Only) by meeting the expenditure from the Head of Account 2401-00-800-28(P). It has also been ordered that the amount Rs. 25 lakh kept for the component "soil testing labs" will be given this year only for meeting running expenditure and such assistance will not be given in future and VFPCK itself should raise the fund for meeting these expenditure from their revenue in future and also subject to the following General Conditions, wherever applicable:

i) All rules, formalities and procedures shall be strictly followed for the implementation of the scheme. The norms of financial propriety shall be adhered to.

ii) The expenditure would be met only from the provision available under the

appropriate head of account.

iii) The fund release will be based on actual requirement, and the fund released should not be parked in banks.

iv) Store Purchase Rules shall be strictly adhered to for all kinds of purchases.

v) Tender/e-tender and other stipulated formalities shall be followed wherever necessary.

vi) Post creation and purchase of vehicles are not admissible under the scheme.

vii) The Director of Agriculture Development and Farmers' Welfare Department shall monitor the implementation of the scheme and ensure that the implementation is as per the existing procedures, rules and regulations.

viii) The implementation agencies/ Departments also should prepare an implementation schedule to complete the project in time and send regular progress report on financial and physical progress on a quarterly basis.

ix) The Director should hold monitoring meetings once in 2 months to review the

progress and send report to Government.

5) The Director, Agriculture Development and Farmers' Welfare Department is authorized to release an amount of Rs. 77.00 lakh (Rupees Seventy seven lakh only) to the Chief Executive Officer, Vegetable & Fruit Promotion Council Keralam.
