The plant health is influenced by several biotic and abiotic factors such as soil, nutrient management, insect pests, diseases, weeds etc. So, there is need to emphasize for synergistic use of complementary management practices to promote soil fertility and plant health through rhizosphere engineering besides weed management. With a view to update the knowledge, skills and management strategies to overcome the stresses that limit plants from achieving their full genetic potential, the below mentioned training courses are designed and offered for agricultural professionals/institutions/organizations.

Further, it is also informed that

- i) **NIPHM will meet the course fee, boarding and lodging charges** of the participants nominated by Government departments, SAUs/ ICAR Institutes.
- ii) Participants will be **reimbursed travelling allowances** as per their entitlement but restricted to 2nd AC train fare on production of the original rail/ bus tickets according to the norms of NIPHM.
- iii) However, the Air fare (**travel by Air India only**) shall be reimbursed to the participants from J&K, North Eastern States and Andaman and Nicobar subject to their entitlement and on production of original boarding pass according to the norms of NIPHM.
- iv) Accommodation will be available at NIPHM hostel, Rajendranagar, Hyderabad for trainees only. No accommodation shall be provided to the family members or guests of trainees even on payment basis.
- v) The NIPHM including hostel and peripheral area are 'No Alcohol Zones' and use of possession of liquor is strictly prohibited.
- vi) It is therefore requested that nominated officers should strictly adhere to the above mentioned terms and conditions.
