ORDER

As per the Government Order read above, Administrative Sanction was accorded for the component "Human Resource group for technology support and capacity building through SAMETI" of the scheme for Hi-Tech Agriculture for an amount of Rs.10 lakh by meeting the expenditure from the Head of Account 2401-00-113-82(P) during the financial year 2020-21.

As there occurred a clerical mistake, the Government Order read above is modified by replacing the para (3) of the order as follows:

"3) The components and objectives of the scheme are detailed as follows:

COMPONENTS

- 1. High Tech Agriculture- Human Resource group for technology support and capacity building
- (a) <u>Training Programme to develop Human Resource Group for technology support</u> and capacity building Hi-Tech Agriculture-Polyhouse:

In order to support entrepreneurs, it is proposed to develop a network of experts and support groups at state and districts level in association with an institution. Capacity building programmes on advanced technologies will be conducted by imparting training to officials of the department (Agricultural Officer/ADA/DDA and Technical Officers) to carryout scientific agricultural development programmes more efficiently. Through these programmes and through filed visits, extension personnels can be exposed to new technologies in the field of Hi-tech agriculture. Training can be conducted at SAMETI, Anayara. The following institutions may be linked for increasing the efficiency of the training.
