The Budget provision for the scheme ‘Rice Development’ for 2020-21 is 11824.00 lakhs. Revised Continuous Administrative Sanction was accorded for the scheme vide reference (1) cited for an amount of **Rs.3484.99201** lakh (**Rupees Thirty four crores and eighty four lakhs ninety nine thousand two hundred and one only**) with the following components:

The component “Operational support to Paddy Development Agencies” was accorded Administrative Sanction vide reference 2nd cited for an amount of Rs.27.68402 lakh for meeting the office expenses of 10 paddy development agencies constituted for tackling the problems of rice cultivation in special problem areas vide reference cited 2nd above. As per the request of the

implementing section for additional fund requirement under this component, the savings available from continuing component "Operational support to Paddy Development Agencies" was re-appropriated and revised sanction was accorded for the component "Operational support to Paddy Development Agencies" also vide reference 1st cited.

Now, as per reference 3rd cited, the implementing section has informed that there are savings available under various components and requested that the available savings may be utilized to meet additional fund requirement for the sub-component "Sustainable Rice Development (Input assistance @ Rs.5500/Ha)".
