CIRCULAR

Sub:- KGSMA Rules, 1960 – Medical Reimbursement of parents of Government Servants - Clarification - reg.

Government vide Circular No.64215/G2/2004/H&FWD dated 31/03/2004 clarified that the expenses incurred in connection with the treatment of parents who are wholly dependent of the Government Employee can only be reimbursed. If the parent is a pensioner, he/she will not be considered as wholly dependent on the government Servant. Now it has come to the notice of Government that EPF pensioners are receiving only a nominal amount as pension.

In the circumstances, Government further clarify that if the parent is an EPF pensioner, he/she will be considered as wholly dependent of the Government Servant.
