

Discrepancies Noticed While Reviewing the Samples Received in the Lab from the Insecticide Inspector

- Not in proper proforma Memorandum to be submitted in Forms V(C); V(D); V(E)
- Copy of Form C also to be forwarded to the lab.
- Proforma are mostly incomplete
- Sample drawn date is not seen mentioned in most of the Memorandum
- Omission of Metallic Seal of Insecticide Inspectors and dealer
- Delay in receipt of samples after the drawal of the samples (The samples should be sent forthwith)
- Some of the samples are not intact and received in leaking conditions.
- Variation in the details submitted in the Memorandum and the Container.
- Not maintaining minimum and sufficient quantity of sample size pack size. The sample pack/size should be of atleast 10gm/10ml.
- Mandatory details like Date of Manufacture, Date of Expiry, Batch No. found tampered and not clear.
- In some cases samples of one chemical bearing the same batch numbers, drawn on the same day from the same depot by same Insecticide Inspector is received; which cannot be considered as 2 or more separate samples.
