CIRCULAR

Sub:- International exposure tour for farmers – directions issued

Ref:- 1) G.O. (Rt) No.944/2022/AGRI dated 02.11.2022.
2) Government Letter No. AGRI-EB2/201/2022-AGRI dated 05.11.2022.
3) G.O. (Rt) No.1118/2022/AGRI dated 17.12.2022.

Government have accorded administrative sanction for conducting National /International tour for farmers for an amount of Rs. 200 lakh by meeting the expenditure from the Head of Account 2401-00-109-80 (Plan) vide reference (1) cited, subject to the following specific conditions:

- a. International exposure tour group shall include 10 farmers and one Government Official to co-ordinate.
- b. Online application shall be called for from progressive farmers with all requisite details.
- c. Transparent selection shall be ensured.
- d. The selection committee shall be chaired by Secretary, Agriculture Department, Director SHM with Director / Nominee and Additional Director (Extension) and Addl. Director, SAMETI.
- e. Duration of visit shall be fixed as four nights stay at the designated country of visit.
- f. Farmers willing to afford air fare at their own cost shall be given preference to a maximum of 50% of the total participants to accommodate maximum full cost participants.
- g. Tour shall be arranged through ODEPC or through crdible private tour operators through quotation process.
- h. Government Official accompanying the farmers shall only seek Government approval as a Tour.
- i. The administrative Sanction for the farmers tour will be issued by the Agriculture Department.

Vide reference (ii) cited, Government had directed to create an online form for selection

of farmers for the proposed international exposure tour and has also issued directions to be considered for the selection of farmers for the International tour as follows:

- Farmers who have registration in the AIMS portal.
- Farmers having 0.4 Ha or more area of land.
- Experience in farming (10 to 30 years).
- Income from Agriculture (Rs. 2 to Rs. 10 Lakh / year).
- Crop diversification and crop relevant to Israel will be given weightage.
- Having 10 + 2 qualification and adequate comprehension in spoken and written English.
- Farmers with age below 50 years.
- FPO membership of farmer will be given weightage.
- Income tax payee will be given weightage.
- 2 to 4 women farmers for ensuring gender equality.
- Farmer having passport with a minimum of six months validity from 1st February 2023 shall be insisted.
- Innovative farmer having keen interest in hi-tech agriculture.
- Farmers willing to defray the air fare.
- Consent from farmers for taking innovative activities and transfer of technologies.
- Certificate of verifying criteria from the concerned Agricultural Officer.
- Farmers should give a feedback after the visit as well as a report on activities undertaken based on the visit to the concerned Agricultural Officers.

Accordingly, online application form for the exposure tour has been developed in AIMS 2.0 portal.

Vide reference (iii) cited, Government have decided that the chosen farmer groups intending to adopt technology will be initially sent to elite Agricultural Institutes and renowned farms in Israel and has directed to proceed with the selection of farmers for the
