CIRCULAR

Sub:- Annual Plan 2024-25- Scheme for 'Strengthening of Agricultural Extension'- Sub component "Strengthening of Project Directorate of ATMA"-Working Instructions issued-reg.

Ref:- 1)Annual Plan 2024-25 2)G.O. (Rt) No. 539/2024/AGRI dated 15.06.2024

As per reference 1st cited above, there is a Budget provision of Rs.2503.00 Lakh for the scheme "Strengthening of Agricultural Extension" under H/A 2401-00-109-80(P) during the year 2024-25. As Government have accorded 2nd cited above. reference implementation of Scheme for the Sanction Administrative "Strengthening of Agricultural Extension" for an amount of Rs.2503.00 Lakh under the H/A 2401-00-109-80(P) during 2024-25. Out of this an amount of Rs. 361.90 Lakh has been set apart for the component 'Strengthening Project Directorates of ATMA including HR Support, ATMA activities and operational support'- under the H/A 2401-00-109-80(P). And under the component "Strengthening Project Directorates of ATMA" a total amount of Rs. 37.627 Lakh (Rupees Thirty Seven lakh Sixty Two Thousand and Seven Hundred only) has been set apart for the sub components "Setting up of District/Block level/Panchayath level ATMA training centres and Hiring of Office space & Contingencies and need-based support for modernization of Head Quarters". under the H/A 2401-00-109-80(P) for meeting various expenses like setting up of ATMA Training centres, hiring of Office space, Tour TA of Extension Personnel, Repair & Maintenance of Departmental Vehicles, POL, etc.

ATMA is one among the efficient approaches in delivering advanced technologies in the field of agriculture as far as the new initiatives in extension are concerned. It is rather an approach than the existing set up which is formulated and advocated by Government of India with a view to achieving the targeted growth in the agricultural sector. The ATMA programmes are aimed at changing the traditional

pattern of implementation of different agricultural plan components and approaching the system in a more professional way. ATMA encompasses the single window system of service delivery irrespective of the farmers enterprises namely, agriculture, animal husbandry, fisheries, dairy, etc

The basic principle underlying this fact is that 'farmer first' approach. In order to improve customer friendliness, offering openness and transparency; content and appearance of the system must be improved substantially. Office appearance has to be improved so as to create an ambience for customer (farmer) friendly transactions. The idea behind this modulation is that better communication and transactions allow for the effective functioning of the system.

Taking into account the above requirements, Project Directorates of ATMA at State level/ District level/Block level can be modernized with latest means of communication and creation of an ambience that would suit the logical and ideal work atmosphere through effective utilization of workspace.

Objectives:

- 1. Setting up of a new/ improvement of existing front office/ help desk facility at ATMA Project Directorates at District level.
- 2. To develop better communication facility among different Project Directorates up to Block Level/ Panchayath Level and with the State HQ.
- 3. To develop a separate 'wing for extension' at district and State HQ to monitor the activities of different project directorates and institutions.
- 4. To set up a better platform for the exchange of ideas, free and fair transactions and improve customer satisfactions.

Programs:-

1. Setting up of District / Block level/ Panchayath level ATMA training centres and Hiring of office space(Rs.29.627 Lakh)

The District Level ATMA Directorates and Block Level ATMA training centres for conducting farmers training, BTT, FAC meetings., etc in each district can be strengthened by

providing furniture, including computer chair and table, scanner, lap top, Xerox machine, voice recorder, net setter, LCD maintenance Facilities, building/furniture projectors, VC requirements, etc based on actual needs. Block wise need based proposal should be approved by District level. District wise need based proposal should be approved by State Nodal Cell. Project Director (ATMA) will ascertain the actual requirements for each block and district. The amount can be utilized for strengthening of block level/Panchayath level information cum training centres and also for hiring of office space. The possibility of sharing market intelligence may also be explored. An amount of Rs. 29.627 Lakh (Rupees Twenty Nine Lakh Sixty Two Thousand and Seven Hundred only) is earmarked for this component and implemented in a need-based mode.

2. Contingencies and need based support for modernization of Head Quarters (Rs.8.00 Lakh)

A total amount of Rs. 8.00 Lakh (Rupees Eight Lakh only) is set apart for this component, which includes an amount of Rs 6.50 Lakh (Rupees Six Lakh Fifty Thousand only) for meeting the travel expenses of extension personnels, expenses related to repair & maintenance of department vehicles, POL and an amount of Rs. 1.50 Lakh (Rupees One Lakh Fifty Thousand only) for providing need-based support like equipment, modernization, security systems, etc. at Head Quarters, for development of Extension Wing of the Directorate, modernization of existing Department Library at Head Quarters and other contingencies are detailed below.
