As per the reference 1st cited above, the Government have accorded Administrative sanction for implementation of the scheme 'Modernization of Department Laboratories' during 2023-24 and vide reference 2nd cited above continuous administrative sanction has been accorded during 2024-25 with a total amount of Rs. 400.0 lakhs, out of which Rs. 20 lakhs is sanctioned for the Strengthening of Biofertilizer Laboratories, Parottukonam & Pattambi under the Head of Account 2401-00-105-86 Plan. These two Bio Fertilizer Laboratories are functioning in the state to make available good quality Bio fertilizers to the farmers at reasonable rate so as to promote organic cultivation of crops.

The targets assigned for production of Azospirillum and VAM during 2024-25 in these laboratories are as follows:

Strengthening of State Bio Fertilizer Laboratories

The strengthening of two existing laboratories include purchase of inert materials like vermiculite, chemicals, purchase of packing material for biofertilizer, repair of laboratory equipments and other miscellaneous requirements.

An amount of Rs. 20.0 lakh is provided for the strengthening of these laboratories under the Head of Account 2401-00-105-86 Plan.

As per reference 3rd cited, Chief Soil Chemist has submitted proposal for Rs. 14 lakh for the various purchases and requirements of SBFL, Parottukonam such as Purchase & Repair of Lab Equipments, Purchase of vermiculite, Lignite, Perlite & chemicals, Repair & Maintenance works & Painting of building, rainshelter and troughs for VAM multiplication, Purchase of polythene covers for packaging, Miscellaneous expenses for the year 2024-25.

As per reference 3rd cited above the Chief Soil Chemist has submitted a proposal for Rs. 6 lakhs for the various purchases and requirements of SBFL, Pattambi such as AMC for Fermenters, purchase of chemicals, inoculums, lab equipments, various Miscellaneous expenses for the year 2024-25.

An amount of Rs 14 lakhs is provided for the Strengthening of State Biofertilizer Lab ,Parottukonam and an amount of Rs 6 lakhs is provided for the Strengthening of State Biofertilizer Lab ,Palakkad
